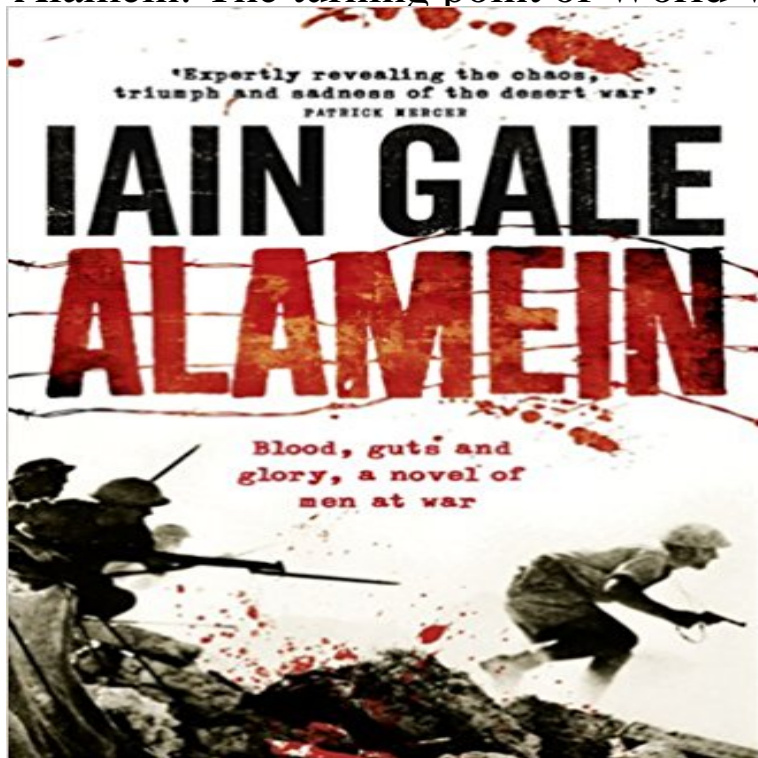


Alamein: The turning point of World War Two
