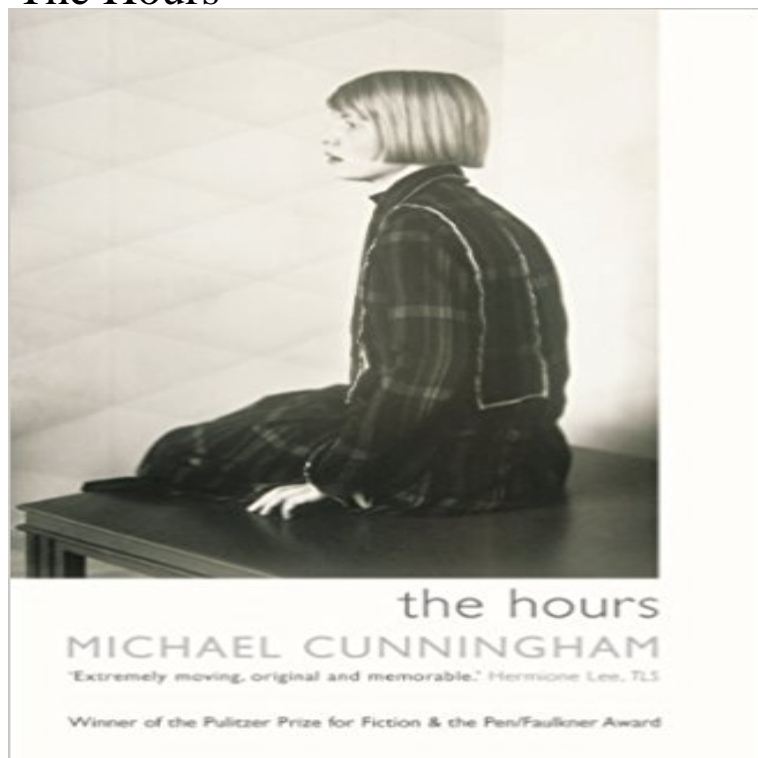


The Hours
